



## SECTION 609 CERTIFICATION FOR A/C

**Effective January 1, 2018, section 609 certification is required to purchase R-12 or R-134a cylinders of 2 pounds or more. Additional requirements apply regarding refrigerant servicing, reuse, disposal, and shop record keeping\*.**
