Pamela's job is to help keep the automotive programs aligned with new technologies and industry needs so that our students have the right skill sets to work on cars -- both the cars on the road and those in the pipeline. Her main focus is to better prepare the Community College Auto programs for zero emission vehicles (ZEVs) and ADAS by obtaining and sharing feedback from key industry and employer partners on the skill sets our students need to perform maintenance and repair on electric vehicles and on advanced electrical systems.

Currently, Pamela is in the process of organizing an EV Academy in our region, to bring faculty and our key industry partners together. The EV Academy's purpose is to expose our California auto faculty to the new electric cars and have our partners describe the cars' new technologies and skill sets our students will need to work on them.
