For Immediate Release Bill to Further Increase Minimum Wage Fails in Committee

Sacramento, June 26 – On June 25, SB 935 (Leno), which would increase the minimum wage over a three year period to eventually reach \$13, failed in the Assembly Labor & Employment Committee. ASCCA opposed this bill and focused much if its lobbying efforts during this year's Legislative Day to stop this and similar job killer legislation.

Go team ASCCA for making a difference by lobbying against this bill. You made a difference!

The ASCCA Government Affairs Committee continues to lobby key legislation that could negatively impact small business. AB 1522 (Gonzalez) would require employers to provide payment of sick leave to all employees. As currently written, an employee who works for one or more days in a calendar year is entitled to sick pay rate of one hour for every 30 hours worked and be limited to 24 hours or 3 days in a calendar year. An employee would be entitled to use accrued sick days beginning on the 90th calendar day of employment.

We need all members to keep up efforts to kill AB 1522. You can do your part by writing your California State Senator asking them for a no vote.
