Enacts the Double Pay on the Holiday Act of 2015. Requires an employer to pay at least 2 times the regular rate of pay to an employee for work on a family holiday.

Allows a credit against the Personal Income Tax Law and the Corporation Tax Law for each registered apprentice trained by the taxpayer in the taxable year. Requires the Division of Apprenticeship Standards to establish a procedure for taxpayers in the form and manner jointly prescribed by the Division and the

Franchise Tax Board to apply and receive a certificate for purposes of the credit.

Exempts categories of persons or entities that did not have a compliance obligation under a market-based compliance mechanism from being subject to that market-based compliance mechanism through a specified date.

States legislative findings regarding the Upward Mobility Act, key provisions of which would expand the application of the Sales and Use Tax Law by imposing a tax on specified services, would enhance the state's business climate and would incentivize entrepreneurship and business investment by evaluating the Corporate Tax Law, and would examine the impacts of lower and simpler Personal Income Tax Law.

Makes technical, nonsubstantive changes to existing law that requires an employer to allow an employee to use his or her sick leave to care for an ill spouse, domestic partner, parent, or child.

SUMMARY:

Provides an individual whose license has been suspended for driving a motor vehicle with a certain blood-alcohol concentration and who is eligible for a restricted driver's license may be eligible for such license without serving any period of the suspension if the person meets all other eligibility requirements and the person installs such device. Requires a person convicted of DUI to install such device on all vehicles owned or are operated. Provides the requirements for a specified restricted license.
